

The Studio Midi WorkShop64 Latest Release Info

Thank you for purchasing the SAWStudio Midi WorkShop 64 Bit Add-In. This file contains the latest enhancements and bug fixes.

The Midi WorkShop is automatically detected by SAWStudio and does not require you to patch it in as a processing plugin. You can access its main window from the SAWStudio *Views* menu, or from the popup *Track List* by Left-Clicking the up/dn arrow zone in the top left corner of the SAWStudio MultiTrack. I highly recommend setting the SAWStudio Timeline to Tempo mode while using the Midi WorkShop program. The main position readout remains in the SAWStudio MultiTrack and should always be left at the top of the screen for reference.

To effectively use the interface, I recommend a minimum screen resolution of 1280 x 1024 and setting up your F-Key Workspace Views so no overlapping windows exist.
